### Is This Just a Story, Or Fact?

- Moses, Jesus, the writer of Hebrews, and Peter all spoke of it as fact
  - Matthew 24: 37 Jesus compares the flood events to his second coming

## What Is the Context of the Story?

• Incredible wickedness to the point that God, filled with pain, sets a date of destruction

#### **Just Who Was Noah?**

- A godly man righteous, blameless, walked with God (like his great grandpa Enoch)
- A family man he was the "real deal" and his family knew this...
- An obedient man his beliefs moved him to action (Hebrews 11: 7 – "holy fear")
- He was a man who persevered over a long span against a lot of discouragement

## The Story that Made Him Famous...

 God lays out the scenario and the plan, and Noah "did everything just as God commanded"

## What Would Noah Say to Us Today?

- Living in evil times is no excuse to go with the flow (Philippians 2: 15)
- The person who endures...who perseveres and overcomes... *this* is the person God uses!
- If you know how it all ends...shouldn't it determine how you live now? (I Peter 3: 10-12)
